ECHA/BPR Regulatory Approvals

The **European Chemicals Agency (ECHA)** works for the safe use of chemicals. It manages the technical and administrative aspects of the implementation of European Union regulation including the authorization of biocidal products.

The **Biocidal Products Regulation (BPR, Regulation (EU) 528/2012)** concerns the placing on the market and use of biocidal products, which are used to protect humans, animals, materials, or articles against harmful organisms like pests or bacteria, by the action of the active substances contained in the biocidal product. This regulation aims to improve the functioning of the biocidal products market in the EU, while ensuring a high level of protection for humans and the environment.

All biocidal products require an authorization before they can be placed on the market, and the active substances contained in that biocidal product must be previously approved. Companies planning to sell their products in one EU Member State must apply for product authorization in that country.
